Our Scope of Services

As this list illustrates, NDC has the experience and resources to treat virtually any dental need you may have. As those needs change over the years, the NDC team will be with you each step of the way, explaining your options and providing first-rate care.

Routine Maintenance Preventive cleanings, x-rays, and exams to combat dental disease in the tooth, gum, and supporting bone.

Oral Hygiene & Periodontal Care Routine teeth-cleanings, supporting-tissue scalings, and more complex "pocket reduction" procedures.

Cosmetic Dentistry A wide variety of services, including orthodontics, bonding, veneers, all-porcelain crowns, gum-tissue shaping, and orthognathic surgery.

Crowns/Bridges A crown creates a new tooth by encompassing an overly filled, fractured, or root-canal-treated tooth. Bridging fills the gap where a tooth has been lost. The teeth on either side of the gap are crowned and a natural-looking tooth is affixed between them.

Implants Replacement of missing teeth by anchoring titanium dental-root forms into the jaws. Natural-looking teeth are then attached to these secure structures.

Prosthodontics Restoration of tooth and jaw function through advanced use of crowns, bridges, implants, and removable dentures.

Advanced Oral-Care Services Based on your needs, your NDC doctor may recommend:

- Full Reconstruction of the dental arch
- Oral/Maxillofacial Surgery (for fractured jaws, dental tumors, etc.)
- Special Care for Medically Compromised Patients

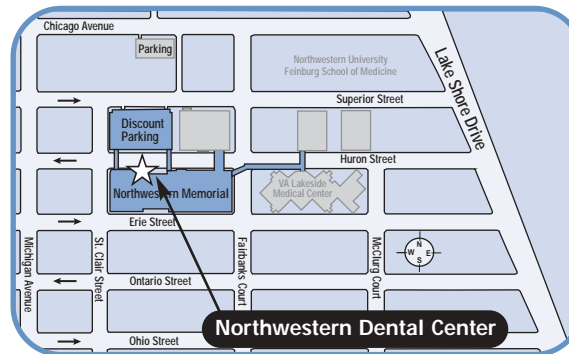
Hours/Appointments/Etc.

New patients will be assigned to a doctor based on NDC's discretion, and occasionally may be treated by another NDC doctor based on schedules and availability. NDC does not offer pediatric dental services; all patients must be at least 18 years old.

NDC is in the Galter Pavilion building, 2nd floor, 201 E. Huron Street, Chicago, just two blocks east of Michigan Avenue and two blocks west of Lake Shore Drive. Huron is a one-way street, with all traffic flowing west, toward Michigan Avenue
